Small Hills:

K5 registration fees are \$10 per athlete. Additional hill (K10) is \$15 per athlete.
K10 registration fees are \$25 per athlete. Additional hill (K25) is \$15 per athlete.
K25 registration fees are \$25 per athlete. Additional hill (K40) is \$15 per athlete.
K40 registration fees are \$30 per athlete.

Big Hill:

K70 registration fees are \$50 per day per athlete.

If applicable, additional hill (K40) is \$15 per athlete.

K70 registrants must have a current USSA number to participate.

At least 3 Men or Women must comprise a Class or Classes (M & F); otherwise will be combined or eliminated.

Nordic Combined:

There is No Cost to participate in the fun run.

The cost to participate in roller ski races is \$10.

Clear Bag Policy

To ensure the safety and efficiency of entry into our events, Norge is implementing a clear bag policy for spectators. All attendees are required to use transparent bags for ease of access. Advertisements detailing this change will be prominently displayed, emphasizing the use of clear bags. To streamline entry, an express lane will be available at the gate specifically for those with clear bags or no bags. Bags that aren't transparent will undergo thorough inspection in a separate, longer gate line. More information can be found at norgeskiclub.org.

Mandatory USSA/FIS Helmet Requirements for all Sanctioned Competitions*

Crash Helmets (*FIS - Specifications for Competition Equipment Edition 2023/24)

The use of crash helmets is compulsory for all events. The shape of the helmet must conform to the shape of the head. The distance measured at any point between the outside surface of the helmet and the head shall not exceed 7 cm.

It is not allowed to attach anything to the helmet surface incl. cameras and holding/fixing systems, unless approved by FIS Race Director / Coordinator. The crash helmets used for international FIS competitions shall comply with the standards applicable for crash helmets for Alpine ski competitions (crash helmets to be used in Ski Jumping).

Compliance with the standards is to be attested by the corresponding specific standardized conformity label affixed in a non-removable way at the back of the helmet in a location which is and shall remain visible. The label shall in particular not be covered by the goggle strap. The conformity label (Label "RH2013") confirming compliance with the standard applicable to helmets to be used for international FIS competitions is shown in attachment. The labels affixed by manufacturers shall comply with the specifications set forth in the enclosure below:

Label attesting conformity with FIS specifications for Alpine racing helmets (GS/SG/DH):
